- Internship:
  - 3 months
  - Full-time
  - Paired with mentor
- Program runs twice a year
  - June Sept
  - Dec March














### **OPW Timeline**

- 1 month application period
  - Pick a project
  - Talk to mentors
  - Submit their first patch
- Mentors choose interns
- 3 month internship

## Status from Round 6

- 41 applicants, 7 interns
- 230 patches in 3.11
  - Cleanups from application period
  - OPW was #13 employer by changeset
- 93 patches in 3.12
  - Laura exposed RSS indirection table in igb for ethtool
  - Lidza merged two out-of-tree TTY drivers
  - Xenia added dynamic debug and trace events to xHCI

#### Round 7

- Applications open through Nov 11th
- Internships run Dec 10th to March 10th
- Next round in April

## Application Patch Review

- Like drinking from a firehose
- Week 1: simple patches, simple mistakes
- Week 2: a few patchsets (3-5 patches)
- Week 3: sparse, coccinelle, "meatier" patches
- Week 4: mostly patchsets (10-20 patches)

## Mentoring

- Big time commitment
- Meet weekly (1 hour or more)
- Support via IRC, email, phone
- Help with community feedback
- Possible time zone differences

# What makes a good project?

- "Goldy Locks"
  - not too easy, not too hard
  - Lots of simple patches = more review
  - Complex project = more mentoring
- Special hardware can cause delays
- Good community feedback
- Is your project already done?
